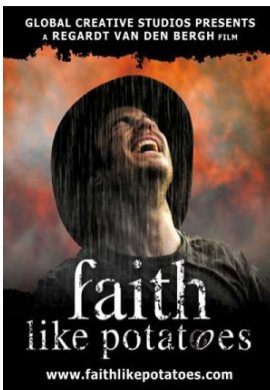

As a lead up to this year's Pako Festa celebrations, Diversitat has joined forces with World Vision to present a Cultural Film Festival.

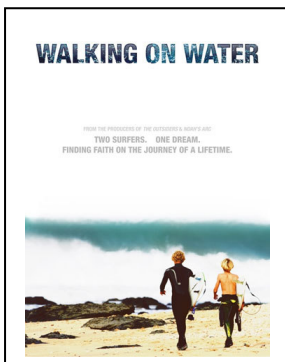
Single film \$10.00, two films \$18.00, three films \$25.00. All proceeds to Diversitat and World Vision.

Released in 2006, the film has been recognised in numerous International Film Festivals including the Fort Lauderdale International Film Festival and the Australian International Film Festival. It was awarded the Audience Choice award at The 2006 Sabaoth International Film Festival (Milan, Italy), and won Best Feature at the 2006 Mumbai International FICTS Festival.

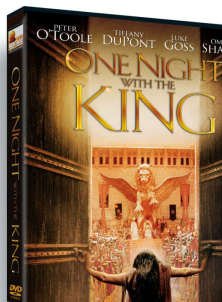
